



Can a person stand in a photovoltaic panel packaging box

Note: When cutting the internal packing strap, the person must stand on both sides of the short side to avoid the modules from sliding down and hitting person due to rough ground.

It is possible to transporting solar panels without harming them by following suitable packaging, handling, and logistic rules.

Standing on a solar panel is generally not recommended and carries significant risk, despite the panels being engineered to withstand harsh weather conditions.

If you opt for taking panels as they are, prepare some sort of solar panel packaging to minimize the risk of cracking the module. Foam pads, bubble wrap, and even blankets - anything ...

This guide serves as a reference for inspecting, transporting, unpacking, handling and storing LONGi PV solar modules to ensure safe practices for you and the modules.

Have one person watch and support the panels from falling over. If necessary, use a stand to support the panels from falling over. Two people lift the panel one at a time by lifting the panel up with 5 both ...

Each module needs to be carried by 2 people, pull the junction box is prohibited in any case, when lifting the module, grab the short edge and take out the module (Figure 5).
