A NiCd charger might do OK to charge NiMH batteries, but I wouldn't assume that without knowing what strategy the charger uses. NiCd are a bit more forgiving than NiMH in charging.

Never use a lithium charger on a NiCd battery unless it's a smart charger that can sense the differences. This is because NiCd Batteries have a nominal voltage of 1.2V while lithium has 3.7v.
