How many 5G base stations are there in India?

India had 469,000 5G base stations at the end of February, according to the latest available figures from the country's Ministry of Communications. The ministry said the number of active 5G subscribers in the country surpassed 250 million in the period - in less than two and a half years since 5G was commercially launched.

How big is India's 5G subscriber base?

According to Finnish telecom equipment provider Nokia, India's 5G subscriber base is projected to rise from 290 million (29 crores) in 2024 to 770 million (77 crores) by 2028, driven by the growing penetration of 5G-enabled smartphones and continued expansion of high-speed broadband networks.
