What is Indonesia energy transition dialogue 2025?

This is the primary focus of the Indonesia Energy Transition Dialogue (IETD) 2025, which was opened on October 6, 2025, in Jakarta by the Institute for Essential Services Reform (IESR) together with the Indonesia Clean Energy Forum (ICEF). The three-day event was held as Indonesia entered a new phase in its journey toward green economic growth.

How important is Indonesia's energy transition?

Energy transitions are unfolding everywhere, but the stakes for Indonesia's shift are particularly important as the world's fourth most populous country, sixth biggest emitter of CO₂ and top exporter of coal. Indonesia is also one of four countries to receive a JETP, along with South Africa, Vietnam and Senegal.
