What should I do if I got a certificate error?

With the unit powered up, press and hold the reset button next to the network port until the LED on the side of the unit flashes green/orange. If the unit is plugged into a closed network ...

Reset This button serves two functions for the UniFi AP:

- o Restart Press and release the Reset button quickly.
- o Restore to Factory Default Settings Press and hold the Reset button for more than five ...
