Solar power, also known as solar electricity, is the conversion of energy from sunlight into electricity, either directly using photovoltaics (PV) or indirectly using concentrated solar power.

Solar panels work through the photovoltaic (PV) effect. When sunlight hits the panels, it creates an electric current that is first used to power electrical systems in your home.

The Net Surplus Compensation (NSC) program allows utilities to offer payment for surplus energy sent back to the electric grid by your home renewable energy systems.

Under a gross metering policy, all electricity generation from a residential solar PV system is sent to the grid and compensated at the wholesale price of electricity, and all electricity ...

This is where compensation mechanisms come to the picture in specifying how an electric utility pays for the energy produced by a customer that is self-consumed and/or exported to the utility grid.
